GENERAL CONCEPTS OF PHARMACOLOGY No medication has a single action; all medications have the potential to alter more that one body function For example, aspirin may be given for anti-infl ammatory action for arthritis, or for antiplatelet action to prevent strokes NURSING PRIORITY: Many medications have several actions that are desirable

Pharmacology in Nursing Practice • Nurse's "Five Rights of Drug Administration " - Use the RIGHT drug - Give to the RIGHT patient - Give the RIGHT dose - Give by the RIGHT route - Give at the RIGHT time • Must also be ready to respond to interaction between drug and patient (ie, must be aware of drug REACTIONS and SIDE
